- I. fince the arrest of her brother by the Cuban G-2, (Date unknown), AMELHOM-1 has developed an acute case of cold feet and she refuses to cooperate further. Using open code letters, LITAMIL-2 prodiced her repeatedly through mic-1962, but was rebuffed by her flat refusal to use 8/4 or any written sears of communication. Her subsequent conversations with LITAMIL-13 were limited to innocuous subjects, apparently by design on her part. Based upon her current attitude, AMELHOM-1 must be considered a dead operation. The projected full recruitment of LITAMIL-13 (see reference B) offers the only possibility of resuscitation.
- 2. LITARII-10 must be also considered a dead operation; the arrangement under which he formerly submitted S/V letters called for the payment of US \$200.00 monthly to his wife in Maxico. Payments were stopped when it became apparent that he had no intention of complying with his reporting obligation. At that point, his wife was given money in the amount of air passage to Spain, which she was supposed to have forwarded to LITARII-10 in PHRUMES. LITARII-2 feel that the lack of reporting was attributable to fear of the regime and the consequence of being caught. Of possible interest is the daim of LITARII-10 that he had, in fart, complied with the obligation, and he claims to have sent many more letters than were actually received in Mexico. LITARII-2 doubts this assertion, and advises against recontact with LITARII-10.

J. Magnier did deliver the letter to LITMAIL-10 in August 1963.
LITARII-10, in turn, gave Regaier a letter for LITMAII-10's wife. Magnier cervied the letter to Paris and mailed it from them. The letter eventually resched Station Mexico through LITMAII-2 on 22 August 1963, but it contained neither open code information nor 8.W. The results of Magnier's trip are not known; again, the recruitment of LITMAII-13 will provide entry into the Prench business community in Revies, which, in turn, may provide interesting operational possibilities in PHIMMER. Engaier did not have instructions to contact AMALSOM-1, but he did contact her and spoke to her at length on the basis of their long friendship AMALSOM-1 appearently hopt the conversations on a social basis with Magnier, also.

4. It is beged that the information given above fulfils the needs catlined in reference (A). Fature requirements along these lines will be given prompt attention. It is requested that the operational clearance on LITABUI-13 be expedited.
